An excerpt from president george Washington's first inaugural address given in New York. On 30 April 1789

"...there is no truth more thoroughly established, than that there exists in the economy and course of nature, an indissoluble union between virtue and happiness, between duty and advantage, between the genuine maxims of an honest and magnanimous policy, and the solid rewards of public prosperity and felicity.... [W]e ought to be no less persuaded that the propitious smiles of *Heaven* ...can never be expected on a nation that disregards the eternal rules of order and right, which *Heaven* itself has ordained...."
